PUBLIC NOTICE No. 10 /2019

Subject: Conduct of online examination of Customs Broker Licensing Examination, 2020 under Regulation 6 of the Customs Broker Licensing Regulations, 2018 – reg.

Attention of all the Importers, Trade and Stake holders is drawn to the Customs Broker Licensing Regulations, 2018 (CBLR, 2018). The written examination of Customs Brokers Licensing Examination, 2020, as amended, shall be conducted by NACIN on 06.03.2020 at the designated examination centers across India.

2. Complete application in terms of Regulation 6 of the Customs Broker Licensing Regulations, 2018 is to be submitted by Registered/ Speed Post in Form-A (available in the CBLR, 2018) along with two passport size photos and self attested documents on citizenship (Aadhaar/ Passport/ Voter Card), educational qualification, financial viability (Solvency Certificate/ Net Worth Certificate), mobile number, e-mail id and other requirements along with the prescribed fee of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) to the Principal Commissioner/ Commissioner of Customs/ Commissioner of Customs (Prev.), having jurisdiction over the area where the applicant intends to carry on his business as Customs Broker from 14.10.2019 to 15.11.2019 up to 06:00 PM. Applications sent by post, in case received after the last date shall not be entertained.

3. The online written examination will be a Computer Based Exam with Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of two and half hours (10:30 hrs to 13:00 hrs) duration. Questions will be bilingual i.e. in English and Hindi. The pattern of the examination will be as follows:

No. of questions	:	150
Marking scheme	:	(+3) for each correct answer and (-1) for each incorrect Answer
Maximum marks	:	450
Qualifying marks	:	270 (60%)

4. The syllabus of examination is prescribed in Regulation 6(7) of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018, as amended. Those qualifying in the said

examination will have to appear for oral examination in terms of Regulation 6 of the said Regulations.

5. The oral examination will be held during the second quarter of the calendar year 2020. The pass percentage marks for qualifying in the oral examination will be 60%.

6. A dummy question paper for the purpose of awareness of candidates will be made available on the CBIC and NACIN websites www.cbic.gov.in and www.nacin.gov.in under the icon/tab <GSTP/CBLR EXAM> from February, 2020. A link to download the admit card will also be provided therein. Admit card shall also be sent by e-mail to eligible applicants 15 days in advance before the date of examination. For convenience of candidates, other necessary details like list of centres, guidelines to the candidates, help desk, e-mail id, etc will also be made available under the said icon/ tab.

7. All the trade Associations/Chamber of Commerce and Members of Regional Advisory Committee and Customs House Agents Association are requested to publicize the contents of this Public Notice among their Members/Constituents, for information and necessary action.
